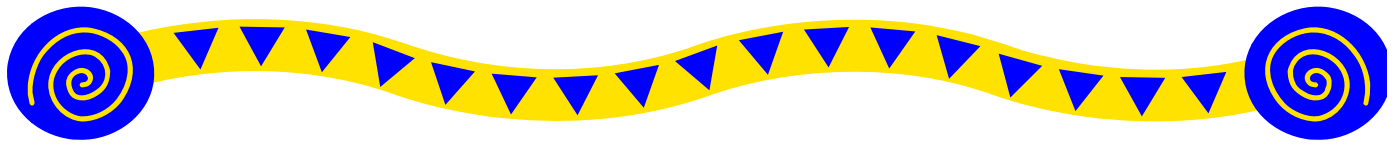


Ever dream of being a *Princess*

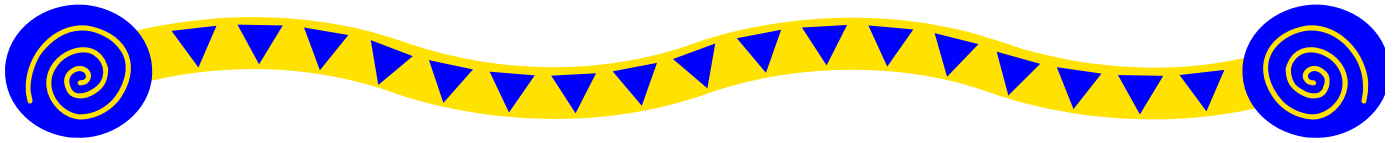
Statement of Understanding
